

HOW DO I APPLY?

To apply for admission to the Summer Institute visit our website: DrewTEACH.org

On your application you will be asked to:

- Articulate your interest in the Summer Institute;
- Summarize your teaching experience;
- Indicate the number of credits desired (1, 3, or 6);
- Ask a supervisor to submit a letter of recommendation to DrewTEACH@drew.edu.

Applications are due by March 15.

CREDITS AND COST

Participants will receive a 50% tuition discount on credits, making each credit \$600.

All participants will be responsible for the same work regardless of the number of credits taken. The lesser credit options are designed to provide teachers who do not receive tuition reimbursement the opportunity to attend.
